When books arrive, do not wait until the second term to purchase that term's books, as the Bookstore usually returns all unsold copies by the end of first term. The division into terms is for the sake of clarity, as is the use of short titles and authors' last names: for full information on each selection, simply search the provided ISBN number online. As noted at the bottom, this list is subject to updating with respect to available editions.
