Please note: Our book order is placed with the Bookstore for the entire year; therefore, the Bookstore typically brings in all the books for the year at the start of the first term. **Do not wait until the second term to purchase that term's books**: the Bookstore returns all unsold copies by the end of first term. Division into terms is for the sake of clarity, as is the use of short titles and authors' last names: for full information on each selection, simply search the provided ISBN number online.
